- 9: TJQs, JQKs

- 11: 4 to a Flush
- 12: 3 to a Royal Flush
- 13: 4 to a Straight, Open
- 14: Pair 22, 33, 44
- 15: 9TJs, 9JQ

- 37: 3 to a Straight Flush, 2 Gaps (0 High Cards, 1 Penalty

- 42: 4 to a Straight Flush, Inside (0 High Cards)
- 43: 3 to a Flush (0 Hi Cards)

TERMS:

High Card:

A Jack, Queen, or an Ace. A pair of Jacks, Queens, Kings, or Aces is the lowest winning hand you can have in Double Bonus Poker. Having one of the hands will win your bet back.

Outside straight:

An open ended straight that can be completed at either end, such as the cards 7,8,9,10.

Inside straight:

A straight with a missing inside card, such as the cards 6, 7, 9, 10. In addition A,2,3,4 and J,Q,K,A also count as inside straights because they are at an extreme end.
